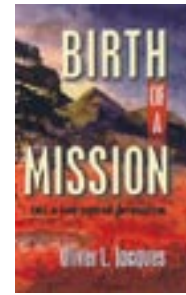


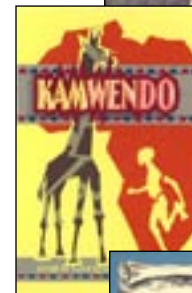
# Family Story Books

## Africa

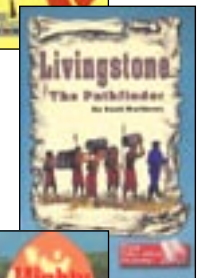

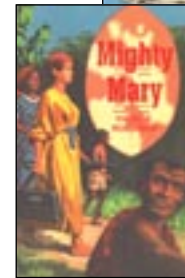
***David Livingstone*** – C. Silvester Horne, M.P. – This is the story of a man of prayer and action. **\$6.95**



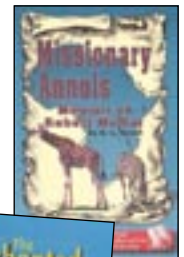

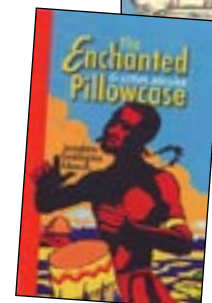

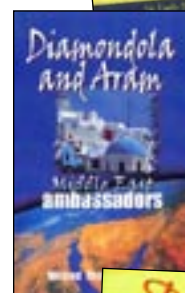
